INTERNATIONAL AWARD 'ANTONIO ROSMINI - FRONTIER THINKER'

The *Accademia Roveretana degli Agiati* and the *Antonio Rosmini Research Centre* of the Department of Humanities and Philosophy at the University of Trento have welcomed the proposal of the *Rotary Club Rovereto Vallagarina* to continue their long-standing collaboration aimed at promoting deeper and more widespread understanding of the great intellectual from Rovereto, Antonio Rosmini, and the frontier context in which he lived and worked.

In this spirit, the institutions have decided to support and highlight the work of young scholars conducting research on Rosmini, by sponsoring the:

INTERNATIONAL AWARD 'ANTONIO ROSMINI- FRONTIER THINKER'

This award is open to scholars born after January 1, 1989, whose original and innovative research contributes to the critical studies on Rosmini's thought in one or more of the following areas:

1. Rosmini's life, context, documents, and correspondence;
2. Unexplored aspects of Rosmini's thought;
3. Rosmini and philosophical traditions in Italy and abroad: sources, comparisons, and reception of his works;
4. Rosmini beyond philosophy and theology: his contribution to pedagogy, law, economics, mathematical, physical and natural sciences, Church history, Italian *Risorgimento*, and the Italian language.

There are two award sections:

1. **Published articles or scholarly contributions** appearing in books or journals (print or online) between January 1, 2023, and October 31, 2025. Publications must have an ISBN or ISSN code. The official date of publication will be the one indicated on the front page.
2. **Master's theses and doctoral dissertations** defended between January 1, 2023, and October 31, 2025.

Submissions may be written in Italian, English, French, German, or Spanish.

For each section, the Jury will select one work, to be recognized as follows:

- The **selected article** will receive an **honourable mention**;
- The **winning thesis** (Master's or PhD) will be awarded a **monetary prize of €1,500.00**. The winner will also be invited to present their work at a public event organized by the Rotary Club Rovereto Vallagarina, on a date to be determined.

The Jury reserves the right not to award the prize and/or the mention, at its sole discretion.

Applicants must submit the following to the Award Secretariat, located at the *Accademia Roveretana degli Agiati*:

1. One **printed copy** of the submitted work, accompanied by a declaration specifying the category (article or thesis);
2. One **PDF copy** of the submitted work;
3. A **photocopy of a valid ID**;
4. A **valid email address and telephone number**;

5. A **signed copy of this call for applications**, confirming acceptance of the rules.

Submissions must be delivered or sent to the Academy's office by **4:00 PM on November 28, 2025**, at the latest.

The Jury will complete its deliberations and announce the winners of the 2025 edition by **February 28, 2026**. Results will be communicated via email and/or phone.

All submitted works will become part of the *Accademia's Academic Library* and will be available for consultation in accordance with the rules of the 'G. Tartarotti' Public Library of Rovereto.

The award ceremony will take place at the *Accademia Roveretana degli Agiati*, Piazza Rosmini 5, Rovereto, during the '**Rosmini Days**' scheduled for the **last week of March 2026**. The exact date will be announced in due course.

The award and recognitions must be collected in person by the recipients, unless serious, documented reasons prevent this.
