In relation to the Announcement of the Prize the following is specified:

1. Can five-year graduates in religious sciences participate with their final dissertation in Section 2 - Master's thesis?

The answer is yes: while the bachelor's degree in theology is recognised by the Italian State as a three-year degree, the five-year diploma in religious sciences and the licence in theology are instead for all intents and purposes equivalent to a *laurea magistrale*.

2. Can a candidate who discussed his thesis in the three-year period 2023-25 and has already published it compete for Section 2 - doctoral thesis?

The answer is yes.

3. Is it possible to submit in Section 1 - scientific articles/contributions and studies jointly published with other authors?

The answer is yes, because the award concerns the article, not the authors.

4. Can two or more pieces be submitted in Section 1 - scientific articles/contributions?

The answer is no, because the committee agreed that you can only compete with one product per section.

5. Can the same candidate participate in both sections?

Yes, provided that only one entry is submitted in each section.

6. Do articles or scientific contributions have to be submitted together with the original paper, or can the paper copy required in the call also be a photocopy or scan?

The answer is yes, scans and paper photocopies of the article or contribution are allowed, as long as they bear the ISBN or ISSN and the date of printing of the title page, as required in the call.
